The Board of Regents approved the following regulation amendments for final adoption. They will become effective on March 28, 2018.

There is a growing movement at the state and national levels for students to learn about computer science in schools. Several national computer science-related organizations collaborated with states, The Clinical Pract ce Work Group has been meet ng regularly to discuss best pract ces and aspirat onal goals for field experiences and student teaching in teacher preparat on programs and has <u>developed draf</u> recommendat ons for changing the regulations related to clinical experiences. The work group collected feedback from the educat on community on the draf recommendat ons through <u>a survey and regional meet ngs</u>. The feedback from the survey and regional meet ngs will be considered by the work group at its March meet ng when it develops the final recommendat ons for the Board of Regents this spring. In May 2017, the <u>Board of Regents approved new program registrat on requirements</u> for school counselor educat on programs that are listed in <u>Sect on 52.21(d) of the Commissioner's Regulat ons</u>. The registrat on requirements are based on feedback from the feld over several years. Programs leading to cert f cat on in school counseling must meet the new registrat on requirements by September 1, 20
