Proposed Revision(s): Revisions requested by this charter school to:

- x Increase its grade span to add Kindergarten through Grades 3 to its current Grade 6 through Grade 6 configuration and to make a corresponding increase to authorized enrollment from 655 students to 955 students by year five of the renewal charter term and
- x Amend the school's KDEs from "A Focus on Effective Teaching and Advancement"; "More Time Learning/Attention to How Time is Utilized"; "Enrichment Courses and Elective Clubs"; "Active Community Involvement"; "A Grades 6-12 College Preparatory Curriculum"; "Intensive and Differentiated Academic Support"; and "A Positive and Supportive School Culture" to "Excellent Teaching"; "More Time for Learning"; "An Enrichment Courses and Extracurricular Activities"; "Active Family and Community Involvement"; "A Grades 6-12 College Preparatory Curriculum"; "Intensive Differentiated Academic Support"; and "A Positive Supportive School Culture."

Both are proposed to begin in the 2023-2024 school year. A determination regarding this revision has not yet been made; it is currently under review by the New York State Education Department.
