Multiple Pathas to Graduation

Multiple pathas recognize the importance of engaging students in rigorous and relevant academic programs. The pathayoptions recognize students' interests in the Arts, Career and Technical Education (CTE), Career Development and Occupational Studies (CDOS), Circs, Humanities, Science, Technology Engineering and Mathematics (STEM), and World Languages by allowing an approved pathayto satisfy students' graduation requirements.

Under the 4+1"pathwayssessment option, students must take and pass fo ur required Regents Exams or Department-approved alternative assessments (one in each of the following subjects: English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies) and complete a comparably igorous pathwayto meet the fifth assessment requir ement for graduation.
