ProposedEmergency Measure to Amend Sections 86.1, 86.2, 86.3, and 86.4 of the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education Relating to the Albert Shanker National Board for Professional Teaching Standards Certification Grant Program William Murphy, Deputy Commissioner for Higher Education, and Elena Bruno, Professional Standards and Practices Board Secretary and Albert Shanker Grant Coordinator, presented proposed amendments related to the Albert Shanker Grantman amendments would revise the eligibility requirements for teachers for grant funds to cover costs associated with obtaining and maintaining National Board Certification.

The Albert Shanker Grant currendingly provides grant funds to teachers to defray the initial cost of obtaining National Board Certification. Nationally Board Certified Teachers (NBCT) ement their certification at their own expense. The proposed amendments would make funding available to National Board Certification at the five ar expiration date as required by the National Board's Maintenance of Certification process.

The amendments also allow firstme candidates who all one or more of the NBT mponents one time opportunity to receive additional funding to retake the unsuccessful component proposed amendment also include technical revisions to update the language of Part 86 of the Commissioner's regulations.

The emergency rule will become effective May 14, 2024. Following the expiration of **they6p**ublic comment period, the proposedmendment is anticipated to be presented for permanent adoption at the July Regents meeting and become effective on July 31, 2024.
