BOARD OF REGENTS AFTELIMS

School Counselr. The new Initial and Professional School Counselor certificates became available on February 2, 2023Candidates also must have applied and qualified for the Provisional School Counselor certificate prior to that dateThe Department has learned of candidates who completed a registered program leading to Provisional School Counselor certification prior to February 2, 2023, but did not substitute a certificate application or did not receive an institutional recommendation certification by this date. To hold these candidates harmless, the Department proposed an emergencytorullbow candidates who complete a New York State registered programation to Provisional School Counselor certification to apply and qualify for this certificate prior to February 2, 2024, extending the deadline by one year.

At its April meeting, the Board of Regents approved this proposed emergency rule. As a result, the Provisional School Counselor certificate application through the "approved program" pathway is now available in the TEACH system and be available until February 1, 2024 Institutions will therefore need to submit recommendations for Proviganal School Counselor certification for program completers in TEACH by February 1, 2024.

TEACHER RESIDENCY PROGRAM REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS

The New York State Department of Labor (NYSDOL) Teacher Residency Programe (TESP) for Applications (RFAs) now posted. Under the RFA, up to \$30 million in TRP funding will be made available to partially or fully fund master's degrees for teacher residents who are enrolled in a registered residency program. These residents must be gradulated PK12 teacher candidates who will complete a residency within a NYS public school district or BOCES program. 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SCHOOL COUNSELOR CONTENT SPECIALTY TEST (CST) FREDERITURISTIYOP

Individuals who are currently enrolled in a New York Stateregistered school counselored ucation program or who recently obtained NYSS chool Counselor certification are eligible to schedule a field test appointment for the new School Counselor Content Specialty Test (CST between May 2-30, 2023. The benefits of taking a field test include previewing actual test items gaining valuable practice in computers ed testing providing feedback that will nform future tests and receiving a \$50 Amazon eGift card OR a \$100 test fee voucher for each field test form taken, which can be applied to future New York State Teacher Certification Examinations (NYSTO) Elest fees.
