## SPECIFICATIONS FOR STORAGE OF NEW YORK STATE EXAMINATIONS

In order to be approved for storage of secondary examinations, the following specifications must be met:

SAFESmust meet or exceed Underwriters Laboratorius (RTL-30 performance standards for burglary resistance manst have: steel door at least 1½ lick steel walls at least 1 lick 750 lbs. minimum weight built-in combination lock sufficient capacity to store the locked Regents boxes for the school's typical examination request (minimum acceptable unobstructed inside dimensions for one box:1"x20"x27")

WALK-IN VAULTS must have all of the following:

pouredconcretefloor

no windows or accessanels

walls of reinforced cement block or concrete, sealed to a poured concrete floor below and structural floor or roof deabove

metal door in a metal frame with interior or weldbid-hinges

built-in deadlatch (dealbolt) combination or key lock that allowsiting at all times
